Cardboard Boat Race Rules 2017

California's Great America is proud to introduce our Annual Cardboard Boat Race in conjunction with Physics, Science, and Math Days! This competition will be held Friday May 5, May 12, and May 19. To find out how you and your school can enter this exciting contest, read the rules and suggestions that follow.

We are encouraging schools to bring fearless students to build a boat out of cardboard in a short amount of time to see who can make it the farthest and the fastest! Up to 20 teams, consisting of four members, may sign up prior to event date. **Please be aware that a \$20.00 Material Fee will be due to participate in this event. This fee will cover the cost of one team. Also, every participant must have a signed waiver to participate.**

Materials to be provided by California's Great America (You are not allowed to use any of your own materials or any additional materials except an oar):

1. Up to 120 square feet of cardboard (You are given several boxes, not one big cardboard box).
2. Up to 60 square feet of bubble wrap.
3. Up to 1 roll of duct tape and up to 1 roll of packing tape.
4. Please provide your own oar (If you cannot provide your own oar, you must propel your boat through the water using your hands.)
5. **California's Great America will provide Personal Flotation Devices (PFD).**

Rules

1. You must pre-register for this contest, please see the team entry form below.
Teams of 2-4 must enter together and a maximum of 20 teams will be allowed to register on a first come, first served basis.
2. **Every team must pay \$20.00 to be able to participate in the Cardboard Boat Race; your payment must be submitted two weeks before you attend Physics, Science, and Math Days.**
3. **Every Participant must have a signed waiver to participate.**
4. You may provide your own paddle and the paddle may only be used to propel the boat. **Note:** Only one paddle per team.
5. Each participant must wear a PFD (Personal Floatation Device to be provided by California's Great America) at all times when in or on the water; otherwise the team will be disqualified.
6. Boats must carry one (1) occupant, the rower.
7. The rower in the boat must not be enclosed above the shoulders. The rower must be visible at all times while the boat is in the water.
8. The designated rower who starts the race must finish the race without leaving the interior of the boat. If the rower exits the boat for any reason during the race, the team will be disqualified.
9. When a boat is finished with the race, the team must remove the boat and any leftover cardboard debris from the water area and dispose of it at the designated trash area.
10. Teams are not allowed to sabotage anyone else's boat. Any rough housing in the water will lead to disqualification.
11. All participants must be wearing a bathing suit and shorts
12. Team members must supply their own towels.
13. Judging will be based on completing the race and the time.

Judging:

1. First, second, and third place prizes will be awarded.

Some suggestions:

1. Decide on a design and sketch it
2. Construct the bottom of the boat first
3. Carefully cover any seam with duct tape
4. Bring a change of clothes, you will get WET!
5. And most importantly, have FUN!
